

2025 SCHOOL CHARGES AND CONTRIBUTIONS

The 2025 School Charges and Contributions schedule is broken into sections and will allow you to calculate all costs that may be incurred throughout the school year. The Coorow School Board has given its endorsement to the following schedule of charges and contributions:

1. Voluntary Contributions

The total amount of contributions parents/caregivers are being asked to pay has again been set at \$50.00 per student which is in line with the School Education Regulations 2000. **We also point out that all contributions are used for the direct benefit of the children. It is vital for the school to receive your family's contribution.** Please pay the contribution within the first two weeks of the school year. If you are having difficulty paying, please contact the office to arrange a payment plan.

Student contributions will be used to assist in the purchase of resources in the curriculum learning areas. The quality of our teaching and learning program is maximised when each family makes its contribution and helps to supplement the funding gained from other sources, including the State and Commonwealth governments.

The table below gives you the breakdown of how your contribution will be directed.
